



HOW TO WORD YOUR GIFT TO THE ARGYLL AND SUTHERLAND HIGHLANDERS REGIMENTAL MUSEUM

For a Residuary Gift:

(A share of your estate)

I give [] (%) of the residue of my estate to The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust, of The Castle, Stirling FK8 1EH, Registered Charity Number: SC042084 absolutely for its general charitable purposes and the receipt of a proper Officer of The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors. Declaring that if the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust has changed its name or has amalgamated with or transferred its assets to any other body, then my Executors shall give effect to such legacy as if it had been made to such body with similar purposes as my Executors may in their sole discretion decide.

For a Pecuniary Gift:

(A fixed sum of money)

I give the sum of [] pounds (£) free of inheritance tax to The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust, of The Castle, Stirling FK8 1EH, Registered Charity Number: SC042084 absolutely for its general charitable purposes and the receipt of a proper Officer of The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors. Declaring that if the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust has changed its name or has amalgamated with or transferred its assets to any other body, then my Executors shall give effect to such legacy as if it had been made to such body with similar purposes as my Executors may in their sole discretion decide.

For a Specific Item:

(e.g. a piece of furniture or a piece of artwork)

Declaring that this bequest to the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust is made on the basis that the Museum Trustees are authorised at their absolute discretion to sell what is bequeathed or to retain the bequest. Declaring that if the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum Trust has changed its name or has amalgamated with or transferred its assets to any other body, then my Executors shall give effect to such legacy as if it had been made to such body with similar purposes as my Executors may in their sole discretion decide.
