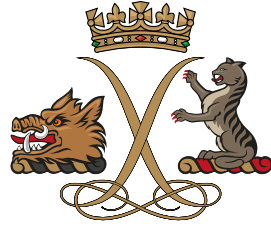

About the Museum

The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum is located in the historic King's Old Building of Stirling Castle. The Regiment's connection with the Castle dates back to its raising in 1794 and to this day the Castle remains its spiritual home.

The Museum moved to its present spot in 1987. It is an accredited museum under the Arts Council England Accreditation Scheme and is a 4* Visit Scotland visitor attraction. The Museum relies on your support to continue its operations.

Looking to the future

The Museum has ambitious plans to redevelop the interpretation of the collection for the 21st century. The Guardians' scheme will contribute towards:

- ❖ Increased gallery space to tell the fascinating story of the Regiment;
- ❖ Improved conservation of the collection and archives;
- ❖ Improved access to our records for research on our website;
- ❖ An extended education programme;
- ❖ An increased ability to mount outreach projects across the regimental area;
- ❖ The creation of a virtual tour of the Museum to improve access to the collection.

The Guardians will help to place the Museum on a sustainable footing for the future.



Joining the Guardians

We welcome both Individual and Corporate Membership of The Guardians.

There are two ways of joining The Guardians:

- ❖ Either by paying a minimum subscription of £5 per month or £30 per year by Direct Debit,
- ❖ Or by paying a lump sum of at least £75.
