In addition, having made all appropriate efforts to offer items back to the original donor, selected items of property of the Warrant Officers' and Sergeants' Mess of 1st Battalion The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders, and the individual companies of 1st Battalion The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders, that are not required by Balaklava Company, 5th Battalion The Royal Regiment of Scotland, the successor of 1st Battalion The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders, or The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental Museum, are to be offered for auction by the Regimental Trust.

## AUCTION

Every Bidder shall be required to obtain a Buyer Number by registering with The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental Museum.

The Hammer Price is the price payable. There is no Buyers' Premium charged. VAT, where due, is incorporated in the Hammer Price.

Any statement by The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental or Museum Trust (as appropriate) in the catalogue of any lots is a statement of opinion only.

All items are sold as seen. Buyers must satisfy themselves by inspection or otherwise prior to purchase.

The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental and Museum Trusts shall have the right at its discretion to refuse admission to its premises or attendance by any person.

The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental and Museum Trusts (as appropriate) have the right at its discretion to refuse any bid, to withdraw or divide any lot and in case of dispute to put any lot for auction again.

All Lots are put up for sale subject to any reserve price imposed.

The buyer shall be the Highest Bidder. If any dispute arises, The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental or Museum Trust (as appropriate) shall have the absolute discretion to settle it.

## COMMISSION BIDS

Prospective buyers are advised to attend the auction. However Commission Bids can be submitted, whereby the auctioneer will bid on behalf of the absentee up to his/her maximum. The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental or Museum Trust (as appropriate) and auctioneer shall not be liable for any neglect in so doing or for failure to do so.

Commission bids must be submitted by email or post to: [collections@argylls.co.uk](mailto:collections@argylls.co.uk). They must be received by 1600 hrs on 24 October 2018. Bids are to be pounds sterling.

## **PAYMENT & COLLECTION**

Buyers must pay The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental or Museum Trust (as appropriate) for items purchased on or before the end of the sale and prior to removal of items. On presentation of the receipt the goods will then be released.

**Payment must be by cheque or cash on day of sale, or by BACS transfer, cheque or cash on collection for Commission bids.**

No goods purchased shall be claimed or removed until they have been paid for in full. All goods purchased shall be paid for and removed at the buyer's risk and expense by 1600 hrs on 2 November. In the event that any goods are not paid for and removed by 1600 hrs on 2 November 2018 The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental and Museum Trusts shall be entitled to dispose of them as they see fit without further notice to the buyer.

The collection of items is the buyer's responsibility. Wherever possible items should be collected on day of sale. The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Regimental and Museum Trusts are not responsible for any damage caused in collection/delivery.
